## **Pregnancy after Tubal Ligation: The New Way Women Are Conceiving Without Surgery**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE** **Raleigh, North Carolina** According to the CDC, more than 650,000 women a year elect to undergo tubal sterilization, some of whom will eventually regret their decision due to a life change or simply a change of heart. While the obvious solution to some might be tubal reversal surgery, in vitro fertilization (IVF) is an option that an increasing number of patients are choosing.

“While for some patients, especially those under the age of 30, tubal reversal surgery may be an ideal way to regain their fertility, no one can guarantee that the surgery will be successful,” says Dr. Bill Meyer of Carolina Conceptions who recommends that every woman undergo ovarian reserve testing before considering tubal reversal surgery.

Advantages of IVF include a shorter recovery time (since surgery is not involved), the option to correct male factor infertility, a decreased risk for ectopic pregnancy, and the ability to screen for genetic abnormalities. Also, patients who undergo IVF do not need to be re-sterilized after delivery since the procedure was never reversed.

Tubal reversal surgery prices and IVF prices can vary greatly. At Carolina Conceptions, patients receive a large discount of 50% off the price of IVF should they choose the treatment over tubal reversal surgery.
